PUBLIC DEED

relating

certification of packaged precious metals

On behalf of [REDACTED], in the name of VUF Limited, according to internet research based in Hong Kong, signatory notary entered today Tuesday, March 27, 2018, from 2.15 pm to 2.55 pm, a secured facility respectively a therein located storage room in order to participate in subsequent act and to draw up present public deed thereon.

In total, three people (inclusive signatory notary) were attending, whereby on detailed address information is waived. The group of persons contained of:

- Constituent respectively staff;
- signatory notary;
- one accompanying person, who is known by Constituent respectively staff.

Staff of the secured facility, that accompanied entry and exit, were present too.

I.

Constituent respectively staff and signatory notary take note of the following :

- In the storage room, there are packaged precious metals, whereof the attending notary shall take record of.
- In the storage room, new, additional precious metals will be stored, whereof the attending notary shall take record of too.
- The attendance of signatory notary and his records during the above-mentioned time is requested.

II.

After arrival of signatory notary at 2.15 pm, above-mentioned group of persons entered into the security tract of the facility. After passing two security gates, a storage room is reached where safe no. 54, which is opened by staff, is located. Subsequently, staff presents five plastic bag out of safe no. 54 to the notary, who confirms that those are existing as follows:

Notary neither proved nor weighed the effective content of the packages.

After certification, staff puts the plastic bags no. 1 to 5 and the envelopes marked with no. 6 to 18 back in safe no. 54. The envelopes marked with no. 6 to 18 are not closed. However, the certified packages inside the envelopes are still firmly closed.

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It is noted that staff presents five firmly closed envelopes, marked with no. 19 to 23, that are opened by staff. Signatory notary confirms, that those are existing as follows;

Notary neither proved nor weighed the effective content of the packages.

After certification, staff puts the envelopes no.19 to 23 back in safe no. 54. The envelopes marked with no. 19 to 23 are not closed. However, the packages inside the envelopes are still firmly closed.

It is noted that staff presents two plastic boxes, firmly closed by cable locks. Staff opens those cable locks in the «0/0/0/0-position».

Signatory notary confirms that the following exists inside the plastic box taped with VUF0205:

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The plastic bag is marked with no. 25 on a folded A4-paper, that is clipped to the plastic bag.

Notary neither proved nor weighed the effective content of the above-mentioned plastic bags.

Staff puts the closed plastic bags no. 24 and the closed plastic bag containing the plastic box no. 25 back in safe no. 54.

Safe no. 54 is closed by staff.

Afterwards, the above-mentioned group of persons left the storage room and the secured facility at 2.55 pm.

Signatory notary confirms having attended the complete act described in this present deed.

III.

Present original remains with the notary. A first copy will be delivered to VUF Limited respectively constituent by electronic means. Present public deed will be translated into English and delivered to VUF Limited respectively constituent by electronic means.
